Candidates should have a terminal research degree (or near completion) and proven records of teaching and research excellence. Both positions require teaching one or two courses per quarter (negotiable) while engaging in joint research with CSUSB Faculty. An AACSB AQ is required.

We welcome candidates who are on sabbatical from other higher education institutions for the visiting professor position and Ph.D. candidates for the visiting research fellow position.
