### **Supply Chain, Logistics, Transportation, and Distribution**

CSCMP – Southern California Roundtable announces the 2008-2009 Scholarship Competition. Four scholarships of \$2500 will be awarded to promising undergraduate students from a Southern California college or university pursuing studies in business, engineering, economics, public policy, and others with a demonstrated interest in a career in supply chain management, logistics, transportation, distribution, or closely related field. These awards are cash grants that can be used for any bona fide educational purpose.

To Apply: Send a letter of qualification to the address below. Letters are at most three pages, plus any related documentation you wish to include, and must contain complete contact information, work and academic history, current work and academic affiliation and standing (Jr., Sr., etc.), degree objective with expected date of graduation, and current GPA. The letter should also describe your civilian, military, or academic work history, previous college attendance, and any project work, personal activities, or other evidence of your suitability and interest in a career in the supply chain industry. You must include a short letter of recommendation from a faculty member or professional colleague familiar with your history, your academic career, or your career goals who should comment on your academic performance and career potential.
